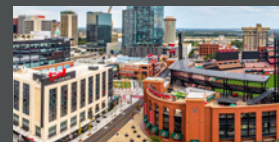

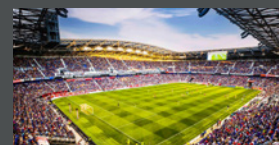
Sports and event venue real estate, infrastructure and operation
