HUNTER IN 'LAW360' ON NLRB MEMO THAT WON'T END MAIL-IN UNION VOTING

St. Louis Senior Counsel Jerry Hunter was quoted July 15 by *Law360* concerning the National Labor Relations Board (NLRB) General Counsel's recent memo setting out guidelines for safely staging union elections during the COVID-19 pandemic. The memo signals that in-person voting is back in play, but it's not the end of mail-ballot elections, experts say. Hunter said he expects most regional directors will follow the GC's advice and call for in-person, or "manual," elections when safe. "Without these guidelines, you would have the board employees conducting the elections basically making it up as they went along," said Hunter, a former NLRB general counsel. "This gives them some guidance on what they should do."
