HUNTER IN 'BLOOMBERG LAW' ON MAIL-IN UNION ELECTIONS UNDER NLRB'S VIRUS FRAMEWORK

St. Louis Senior Counsel Jerry M. Hunter <u>was quoted Dec. 21 by *Bloomberg Law*</u> concerning the National Labor Relations Board's (NLRB) decision to order mail balloting in every union election scheduled, and how employers are responding. "It isn't reasonable for an employer to request a manual election when pandemic statistics virtually guarantee that regional directors will order mail balloting," said Hunter, who is also a former NLRB general counsel. "Employers should use their energy to negotiate for something as part of a stipulated election agreement, like longer or shorter election deadlines," Hunter also said,.
