ATTORNEYS PEN ARTICLE ON UK SUPREME COURT DECISION

BCLP Senior Associate Rachel Ziegler and Knowledge Development Lawyer Gilly Bradbury authored an article for *Lexis PSL*, first published Nov. 10, on the UK Supreme Court's recent judgment in *Crown Prosecution Service v Aquila Advisory Ltd [2021] UKSC 49*. The case involved confiscation orders that were contested by those with a proprietary interest in the secret profits acquired by directors who had acted in breach of their fiduciary duty.
