FIRM REPRESENTS ROYAL BANK OF CANADA IN \$60 MILLION REFINANCING OF ASSET MANAGER

The global law firm Bryan Cave Leighton Paisner represented Royal Bank of Canada (RBC) in connection with a new \$60 million credit facility for CBAM Holdings LLC and CBAM Partners LLC (collectively, CBAM). The facility was led by RBC Capital Markets as lead arranger and sole bookrunner, RBC as administrative agent, and Barclays Bank PLC as syndication agent. Proceeds of the facility will be used to refinance a working capital facility provided by CBAM's parent, Eldridge Industries, and pursue growth initiatives including expansion into new geographies and seeding new investment strategies.
