CORONAVIRUS (SCOTLAND) ACT 2020: EXTENSION OF PLANNING PERMISSIONS

SUMMARY

In a welcome move for clients with development interests in Scotland, the Coronavirus (Scotland) Act 2020, which came into force on 6 April 2020, applies an automatic extension to planning permissions that are due to expire during the current crisis, a measure which is not currently available in England.
