
COULD ZONING WORK IN THE UK?

The Government has announced that this month it will launch a Planning Policy Paper "setting out our plan for comprehensive reform of England's seven-decade old planning system, to introduce a new approach that works better for our modern economy and society". Early signs are that this might include proposals for some kind of zoning regime.
