SEGUN OSUNTOKUN QUOTED IN 'THE SUNDAY TIMES' ON DIVERSITY ISSUES

London Managing Partner Segun Osuntokun provided his thoughts Feb. 14 to *The Sunday Times* concerning progress the city of London has made on diversity. The piece highlights Segun's open letter first published by *The Lawyer* magazine in July 2020. He told *The Sunday Times* about his decision to speak out last year, following the Black Lives Matter protests and conversations with his family. He outlined his belief that firms should make "hard, data-driven commitments" to disclose diversity statistics and embrace "the public accountability that goes with it." He concluded, "The unfortunate events last year did create a momentum... I'm not saying that it's not a huge challenge. But I think there is a certain urgency now."
