WEBINAR- GOING PUBLIC IN THE U.S. – WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

On Wednesday, July 14, BCLP's U.S. Securities and Corporate Governance group and Israel group presented a webinar exploring the steps and key requirements to prepare for a U.S. public offering on Nasdaq or NYSE. They also discussed the U.S. foreign private issuer (FPI) regime, highlighting particular differences and considerations for FPIs along the course. Finally, the panelists explored trending topics for new public companies to bear in mind in 2021 including an in depth look at board diversity initiatives, minutes and developments in ESG requirements.
