BCLP ADVISES AMBER INFRASTRUCTURE LIMITED ON UTILITY SCALE LITHIUM-ION BATTERY ENERGY STORAGE PROJECT

International law firm BCLP has advised Amber Infrastructure Limited on the development and management of a utility scale 49.9MW lithium-ion battery energy storage project which will deploy Megapack, Tesla's large-scale lithium-ion battery technology.

The transaction is one of the first of its kind in the UK and marks a key development in the transition towards a low carbon electricity network enhancing the utility of the generation of electricity from intermittent sources such as wind and solar PV. Bringing together an experienced infrastructure investor with a well-known battery storage provider, the collaboration will allow access to the various revenue streams available through the intelligent management of electricity including energy trading and generating revenue through ancillary services.
