Shy's session on 4 October will focus on "*Mainstreaming Collaborative Delivery Models*" and in particular, the "*Lessons Learned from Using the NEC Model*." Shy will explore the potential of collaborative delivery models in establishing balanced contracts with an adequate risk profile, thereby improving project outcomes and future business prospects.
