BCLP has supported the publication of the Construction Leadership Council's (CLC) Mental Health Joint Code of Practice (JCOP) as a programme partner – a new, industry-wide framework designed to improve mental health outcomes, through long-term systemic change, across the construction sector. The JCOP is endorsed by the UK Government.
