CAPITAL GAINS TAX RECEIPTS: ELIZABETH BRADLEY QUOTED IN GB NEWS

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Summary

Elizabeth Bradley, Global Practice Group Leader for our Tax, Employee Benefits and Private Client practice, was quoted in *GB News* on 30 August 2026 in an article examining record Capital Gains Tax (CGT) receipts and whether the recent increase can be sustained over the longer term. Elizabeth warned that the rise in CGT liabilities may be temporary and driven by taxpayers bringing forward disposals ahead of anticipated tax changes.

Elizabeth Bradley, a partner at law firm BCLP, warned the increase "may be a sugar hit caused by forestalling".
